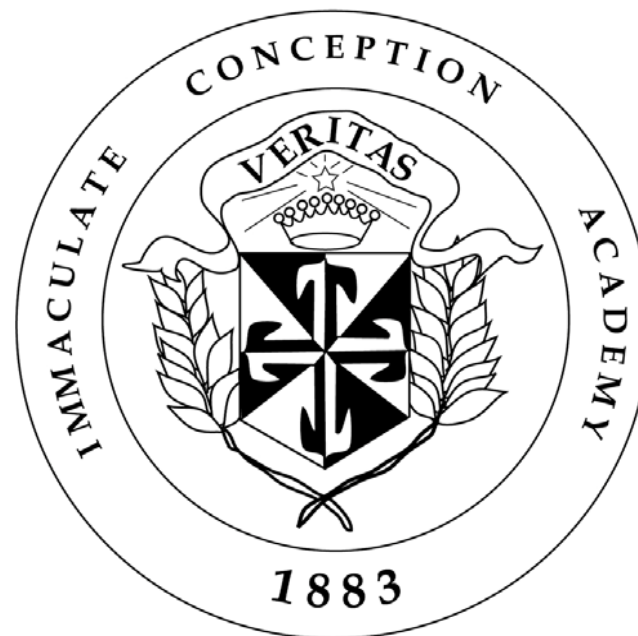

NOTE: Since we are a small school, we do not offer several sections of courses which prevent students at times from taking desired courses due to scheduling conflicts.

GRADING AND CLASS RANK

The calculation of a student's academic standing is based on a weighted grade point average and includes all courses (**no extra points are given to Honors Biology, Honors Modern World History or Honors Algebra II**). Valedictorian is selected on the basis of the highest 7th semester cumulative weighted GPA. Grade reporting is 4 times per year with class rank based on a weighted semester grades. Lowest passing mark is a D-. GPA is calculated on a 4.0 scale.
